During the year 1918, through several communications this Municipality tried to get the granting of a road allowance starting between Sections three and four 21-23-4, and leading down the hill to the Big Bow River Bridge south of Gleichen.

This road would extend probably one-half mile through the holdings of the Blackfoot Indians, but would in no way harm their land.
