I need Dr. Turnbull's report on the
Kootenay Belle Mine. If it has served its purpose I

What do you think of the new treaty?
We have no details yet but in view of the fact that we
have been under great expense in providing relief for
the prairie farmer and in maintaining the Wheat Board,
it seems to me our friend MacKenzie-King has been very
generous at the expense of the three prairie provinces
and the transportation companies as well as the tax-
payer. If he has been as careful of the interests of
the industrial population in the East we are heading
for another adverse trade balance running into the
hundreds of millions.
