Dear Sir:

I regret that your recent request for information with respect to the registration of the unemployed residents of this municipality has, to date, remained unanswered. However, the fact that the unemployed in this area have not been registered for about three years makes available information rather useless.

The following figures supplied by our Public Welfare Department, indicate the number of families registered as receiving relief:

3,648 - Heads of families
11,592 - Dependents
946 - Single men and women

1934 population, Windsor
only, is 63,010

You will doubtless realize that the above figures do not include many persons who are unemployed but who by reason of pride or other circumstances, refrain from calling upon the Public Welfare Department for assistance.
