Sir,-

Inspector Macrae reports that the Chief and Indians at Rice Lake Reserve complain that the West boundary of the Reserve should run North Sixteen Degrees - Forty Minutes West, instead of North Nineteen Degree - Twenty-six Minutes West.

If this were done the line would run further East and a strip of considerable width would be taken off the Reserve.
