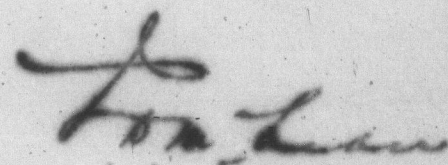
With Cheque.

With reference to your letter of the 27th ultimo, with which your forwarded Voucher No 3919 for \$17.00 in favour of the Police Magistrate, Mr S.W. Taylor, I beg to say that the account was, in accordance with the usual custom, sent to the Department of Justice for taxation, with the result that it has been reduced by 75¢. In connection with the reduction the Department of Justice observes that the Magistrate has two fees one for opening Court \$1.00 and one for three hours attending Court 75¢. "For these two items he is only entitled to \$1.00."
