



I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 6th Instant, submitting copy of a resolution passed by the Chippewas of Saugeen Band in favour of certain Indians whose names are given, to cut 8 cords of firewood on the Saugeen Reserve for use of the Church, and in reply to inform you that free permits may be issued for this quantity to the Indians who offer to cut and deliver it on the terms stated in your letter.
