Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 8th instant, inclosing a letter addressed you by Messrs. Johnson Bros., of Forest, in regard to their desire to secure a lease of land on the Kettle Point Reserve for the purpose of raising fruit, and in reply to say that, in view of the representations made, the Department would be disposed to give favourable consideration to the proposition, and if the applicants would specify the particular lots they wish to lease and the lots designated are located to individual Indians, the Department would consider the question of leasing the lots under a written agreement entered into between the proposed lessee and the locatees, embodying all the terms and conditions necessary for the issue of Departmental lease.

You will be good enough to take this matter up with the Johnson Bros., and the Indians, and report thereon as soon as anything definite has been arrived at.
