
Ottawa, Mar. 3rd, 1916.

Gentlemen:-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th ult., making inquiry regarding the sale of horses by the Department. In pursuance of your A.D. to inform you that date at the rate of 40 cents per horse or 100 dollars must be paid by the band and amount up to Col. John Sheridan, Indian Superintendent of Balsam Lake. Before the horses are sold from the Reserve.

The horses will be sold at public auction.

There will be 100 horses given to eight Indians, 12 horses to each Indian, 12 horses to each side each.
