

Sir,-

With reference to that portion of your report of inspection of the Quamichan Roman Catholic Day School, I beg to say that a grant for ten extra pupils is being allowed the Kuper Island Industrial School to meet the educational wants of the Roman Catholic children of the Quamichan Reserve. Both Mr. Agent Robertson and the Principal of the school are being so informed and requested to take the necessary action to place that number of Roman Catholic children from the Quamichan Reserve in the Kuper Island Industrial School at as early a date as possible.

It is not the intention of the Department to re-open a day school for Catholic children on this reserve.
