A I could not find the place.

Q Did you visit Princess Royal Island?

A Yes.

Q Who accompanied you on the visitation?

A Robert Hawkins.

Q Were there any Indians with you?

A He is an Indian.

Q And one of the interested Indians?

A Yes.

Q Was he the man that brought this application before the Commission?

A Yes - I think it is meant for Kitasee.

Q Did you find Kitasee?

A Yes.

Q (Examining tabulation) And you think this should be Kitasee, on Princess Royal Island?

A Yes.
