long ago, you may be well
informed of the state of things, which
are now very much altered so
as to give us water from the Colorado.
For the other two rivers, Rio Grande
and Pecos, give the surface water,
which is of little use to the
Mexicans except for their
irrigation works. The water is
now running the Colorado, so
that it is in total want of the
Colorado water and the white settlers
have no water. On Monday
the 1st we took to the Lower Rio Grande
and this is within the 20 mile belt
of water which is the higher Rio Grande
waters of the Mexican and Colorado
rivers. There has been a state border
line between the Mexican and Amer-
ican states.
Believe me. At my invitation of the
people and especially the Indians.
