

other notices mentioned in this Act. The appellant must also deliver a copy of such notice to the Clerk of the Division Court of the Division in which the land lies, which Clerk shall immediately notify the Judge of such appeal, whereupon the judge shall appoint a time for the hearing thereof, and, if he think fit, order such sum of money to be paid by the appellant to the said Clerk as shall be a sufficient indemnity against costs of the appeal, and the judge shall order the time and place for the hearing of the appeal, and communicate the same to the Clerk, who shall notify the fence-viewers and all parties interested, in the manner hereinbefore provided for the service of such notices under this Act, and the Judge shall hear and determine the appeal, and set aside, alter, or affirm the award, correcting any error; he may examine parties and witnesses on oath, and, if he so please, may inspect the premises; he may order payment of costs by either party, and fix the amount, and his decision shall be final; and the award as so altered or affirmed, shall be dealt with in all respects as it would have been if it had not been appealed from.

12. Any agreement between owners respecting such line fence in writing may be filed or registered and enforced as if it was an award of fence viewers.

13. The forms in the schedules are to guide the parties, being varied according to circumstances.

14. This Act is not to affect any proceedings under former Acts.

15. This Act may be cited in any proceeding or document as the "Ontario Line Fences Act."
