

or weekly, at fixed hours during the season of navigation, for the purpose of advising and aiding the Emigrants.—In the same office, shall be kept by the Agent, a register of all applications to the Society, for domestic servants, laborers, gardeners, farmers, and mechanics, as also of the names and qualifications of Irish Emigrants in want of employment, together with a list of lands and real property for sale in this Province.

**THE COMMITTEE OF ACCOUNTS, AND THE
COMMITTEE OF INSTALMENTS.**

Article XVIII.—A Committee of Accounts, consisting of five Members, not being Officers, shall be appointed annually at the Preparatory Meeting, whose duty it shall be to examine the books and accounts of the Treasurer and Secretary, and to make report to the Society, on St. Patrick's Day ensuing.—At the same meeting a Committee of two Members shall be appointed, who shall, on the Anniversary Festival, present and instal the Officers elected, for the ensuing year.—These Committees and all Special Committees, shall be nominated by the presiding Officer, and appointed by vote of the Society.

THE FUNDS OF THE SOCIETY.

Article XIX.—If at any time there should be more money in the hands of the Treasurer, than the exigences of the poor require, the same shall be loaned out at interest, or otherwise disposed of, as may be determined on by the
