"street shall be widened within one year from the annexation, from the public road to lot 291-16 of the Official Plan and Book of Reference of the Parish of Saultau-Recollet, and College street shall be widened thirty
three feet from the public road to the entire depth of lot
no 292 of the Official Plan and Book of Reference of
the Parish of Sault-au Recollet, and to that end, the
city shall acquire the necessary land at the price of
thirteen thousand dollars according to the options given
by the owners interested."

Written options of promises of sale for the necessary land to effect this widening were held by the mis-en-cause Menard from seven parties, Dame Evelina Bruneault, widow of Arsene Pigeon, Dame Cordelia Deslauriers, widow of Arsene Blondin, Alfred Martineau, Antoine Deslauriers, Vital Nantel Harry Goldberg and Pierre Parent, which said Menard offered to transfer to the city defendant, and certified copies are produced of record, showing the areas and terms, amounting in the aggregate to the above mentioned sum of \$13,000.

The first move on the part of the city towards carrying out this legislation and putting it into effect appears to be a report or recommendation of the 2nd December, 1910, of the Board of Commissioners of the defendant to the city council to the effect that after having considered the offer of the mis-en-cause Menard to sell, cede and transfer the land required for the widening of St. Anne and College streets for the sum of \$13,000, as contained in the options of the proprietors interested, the recommend that a credit of \$13,000., be voted for such purpose by the city council, seeing that the city is bound thereto as a condition of the annexation of Bordeaux Ward, adopted by the Legislature, and recommending that a notarial deed be
