fold within or brought into this Province, and for the more effectual improving and extending the Trade of this Colony to the West-Indies, shall be and continue, and the same is hereby continued in Force, from the Expiration thereof, until the Thirty First Day of December, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Eight.

CAP. III.

An Act for farming the Duties of Impost and Excife on Beer, Rum and other distilled spirituous Liquors, and Wines, Brown Sugar and Melasses at the several Districts therein-mentioned.
