rifon in faid Province, or any of the faid Truck-Masters, in case no fuch Justice be resident at or near such Fort or Garrison, upon Information either by the faid Indians themselves, or any other Person or Perfons whatsoever, made of such illicit Trade, to apprehend the faid Master, and keep him in Custody, and to detain the faid Vessel and Goods to illicitly purchased of or bartered for with the faid Indians, until the said Matter be fully enquired into, and finally determined; and all His Maiestry's Justices of the Peace, Officers of Forts and Gartisons, and Truck-Masters, and all His Majestry's Subjects within said Province, are hereby required and directed to aid and affist in the due Execution of this Act.

And it is alfo-hereby enacted, That all Fines, Forfeitures, and Penalties incurred by this Act, thall be recovered by Bill, Plaint or Information, in any of His-Majetty's Courts of Record in this Province, (except in the Cale where any Ship or Vefiel may be deemed liable, in which Cale the fame thall be tried and determined in His Majetty's Court of Vice-Admiralty) and thall be paid one Half to the Treasurer of the Province for the Use of the Government, and the other Half to the Informer, who thall tue for and recover the fame.

And it is also further enacted, That this Act shall continue and be in Force for and during the Term and Space of Two Years, from and after the faid Twenty-fir/t Day of May, 4760, and no longer.

An ACT in Addition to an Act, intitled, An Act for preventing Trespaffes.

HEREAS by an Act made and peffed in the Thirty-fecond Fear of His Majefly's Reign, intitled, An Act for preventing Trespaties, it was enacted, "That it should be lawful to impound " any Swine going at large, within the Streets, Lanes, or Su-" burbs of the Town of Halifax;" And whereas no Provision was therein made for inclosing Ground for a Pound;

Be it therefore enabled by His Excellency the Governor, Council, and Affembly, and by the Authority of the fame it is hereby enabled. That a Pound shall be forthwith made of Forty Feet square, at the public Expence, and that the Grand Jury of the Supream Court, to be held in April next, shall appoint a Keeper of the same.

And be it further enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That if any Damage thall be done by breaking any Inclosures, and destroying any of the Produce thereof, by any Horses, Sheep, Goats, Swine, or NeatCattle, it shall and may be lawful for the Person or Persons whole Fence or Fences shall have been to broken, and whole Inclosures shall have received such Damage, to cause the faid Horses, Sheep, Goats, Swine, or Neat Cattle, to be impounded until the Owner or Owners of such trespassing
