The fall of Bagdad, besides ending German hopes of Near Eastern dominion, based on a Berlin-Bagdad railway, will reverberate throughout the Mohammedan empires, and it is believed will more than rehabilitate British prestige in the Far East, damaged by the earlier loss of Kut-el-Amara.

Further news must be awaited before it is known whether General Maude made important captures of Turkish troops or guns, either before or at Bagdad.

Hindenburg Plans New Offensive Against Italy

Huge Teuton Armies Are Collected on Trentino Front; Italians Actively Preparing For Renewed Hostilities

Italian Headquarters, March 11.—Cold, snow and ice of an unusually rigorous winter have augmented the difficulties of warfare in the Trentino but have not succeeded in deadening the activity of the opposing armies.

First—The Austrians have pinned down on the Trentino front between two and three times as many men as were there last year.

Secondly—With her vastly improved communications they could at short notice transport men and guns more quickly and in greater numbers than last year.

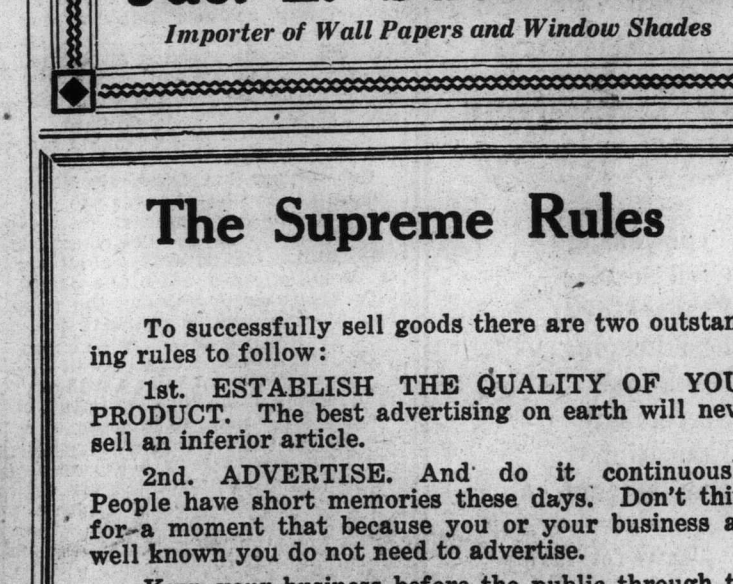
