BOLSHEVIKI REPULSED.
By Courier Leased Wire.
Archangel, Wednesday, Nov. 13.—(By the Associated Press).—Bolshevik forces have resumed their attacks against the American and British positions at Tulgas on the Dvina River. They have been repulsed with severe losses.
On the morning of November 11, after a heavy bombardment from their gunboats and barges in the river the Bolshevik infantry stormed the Allied position, with entanglements and succeeded temporarily in reaching the gun emplacement of the Canadian artillery.
Tulgas is on the Dvina River, south of that village, is joined by the River Vaga. It is in the province of Archangel, a few miles west of the border between that province and the province of Voloiгда.
