A NEW MINISTRY TO BE The Clerkenwell Affair, The Prisoners all to be Tried FENIAN OUTRAGE AT CORK Latest from Abyssinia ! AN AMERICAN CAGED BY NAPOLEON TREATY BETWEEN THE U, S. BY ATLANTIC CABLE. London, 24th eve. Earl Derby has resigned the Premier-ship, and his resignation was accepted by the Queen. Mr. D'sraeli will replace Earl Derby as Prewier, retaining his present post as Chancellor of the Exchequer. In the house of Lords this afternoon, at the beginning of the session, the Earl of Malmsbury announced that Lord Derby has tendered his resignation to the Queen on account of continued ill health, and that Her Majesty had been pleased to call upon the present Chancellor of the Ex-chequer, the Right Hon. Benjamin D' Israeli, to form a new Cabinet. Earl Mussel and others expressed their, sympa-thy for Lord Derby, and hoped he might recover from his illness and re-ume his post at the head of the Ministry. In the House of Commons to day the Prime Minister was made by Lord Staa-ley, and was responded to by Mr. Glad-stone, who, with much delicacy and foel-sing expressed his sortow for the cause which compelled the noble Lord to re-sign his high office. The transaction of all business in the House was postponed until Friday next.
