trust our Saviour Jesus-he faid " Yes I have often pray to him in my heart."

The New-York miffionary Society have attempted the conversion of some of the near Indians, and have commenced a mission to the remote tribe of the Chickafaws. Nor have the missionary societies of Massachusetts and Connecticut been inactive.

Letter to the Rev. E. Holmes, from David Fowler, a truly religious man, a principal chief, and who is called a peace-maker of Brotherton. The letter was dictated by the chief, and written by his fon.

Dear Brother,

The Lord our God has once more brought you up here in our town; though we live at fuch a diftance, yet we are permitted to fee one another this fide the grave. Dear fir, you are welcome in this our town, and you are welcome in my houfe; and I do rejoice to fee you have fuch regard and pity for poor Indians.
