

AGREEMENT ON ENVIRONMENTAL CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE  
GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF  
THE UNITED MEXICAN STATES



The Government of Canada and the Government of  
the United Mexican States (the Parties),

RECOGNIZING the global character of important  
environmental problems;

CONVINCED that it is in the interest of all  
States to pursue policies toward sustainable development;

CONVINCED also that environmental co-operation  
between States is of mutual benefit at the national,  
regional and international level;

CONSCIOUS of the need for enhanced co-operation  
with respect to migratory species of great interest to  
both States, and

TAKING INTO ACCOUNT that environmental policies  
require the development and implementation of  
environmental protection and control measures, based on  
research and environmental monitoring,

HAVE AGREED as follows:

ARTICLE I

The Parties shall maintain and expand bilateral
