

With the exception of eleven post territories (Atlanta, Boston, New York and Seattle in the USA, Egypt, Japan, Mexico, Norway, Portugal, Switzerland, Venezuela), Canadian exports of fish and seafood products represent less than 5% of domestic consumption. This suggests that there is considerable room for additional Canadian exports.

The summary chart on the following page indicates those posts which have specifically identified fish and seafood as candidates for particular attention, as well as the market characteristic for seafood imports generally and whether seafood currently falls among the top six Canadian exports by dollar value to the territory.
