Referred to the Standing Committee on Railways, Telegraphs and Harbours.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the Bill (E), intituled: "An Act to incorporate Ottawa Valley Trust Company," was read the second time, and— Referred to the Standing Committee on Banking and Commerce.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the Bill (F), intituled: "An Act respecting The Quebec Railway, Light and Power Company," was read the second time, and—

Referred to the Standing Committee on Railways, Telegraphs and Harbours.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the Senate resumed the adjourned debate on the consideration of His Excellency the Governor General's Speech from the Throne at the opening of the present Session of Parliament, and the motion of the Honourable Senator Robinson, seconded by the Honourable Senator Dupuis.
