

had been duly made within the first six years from the date of the said patents.

7. If any person has within the periods between the expiry of six years from the respective dates of the said patents and the eleventh day of November, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, commenced to construct, manufacture, use or sell in Canada any inventions covered by the said patents such person may continue to construct, manufacture, use or sell the said inventions in the said manner as if this Act had not been passed.
