MEDICAL EVACUATIONS

Question No. 242—Mr. McGuire:

1. In 1989, did the Department of National Defence expend any flying hours conducting medical evacuations from Prince Edward Island and, if so, what total number of hours?

2. Has the government spent \$3.9 million on Prince Edward Island medical evacuations and, if so, over what number of years?

Hon. William Hunter McKnight (Minister of National Defence):

1. Yes, 111.6 hours.

2. The 413 Squadron offers both search and rescue and medical evacuation services. Medical evacuation is a provincial responsibility and Prince Edward Island is the only province in which the provincial government does not offer its own medical evacuation services. The federal government, using the 413 Squadron, provides medical evacuation in Prince Edward Island and then bills the province. Between 1 April 1973 and 31 Decem-
