unless a proper discrimination be exercised at home, the Society would not feel safe in appropriating their means for the latter object. We would further state, that farm servants, well acquainted with the various branches of hubbledry, would be well rewarded by coming to this country for that purpose alone, as they could realize from £18 to £30 currency per annum for their labour.
