which they are taken noted on Scrap Book. He shall deliver to the Local at the expiration of his term all property entrusted to his care.

TREASURER'S DUTIES

Sec. 5.—It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to receive from the Financial Secretary all balances of monies collected by him; he shall report quarterly all monies received by him, and submit his books to the Auditing Committee when so desired. He shall deposit all money in the bank that the Local may select in the name of the Union, only to be drawn upon drafts signed jointly by himself and the President; he shall give such bond as the Local may request.

Sec. 6.—The offices of Warden and Conductor will be so conducted as to conform with the ritual of the Union.

DUTIES OF EXECUTIVE BOARD

Sec. 7.—It shall be the duty of the Executive Board to supervise and direct the management of the Local. It shall constitute the Grievance Committee and shall investigate all disputes and questions between members of the Local and the Police Department, and report their findings to the regular meetings of the Local in writing. They shall appoint their own time for meeting, which shall be at least once a month. Special meetings may be called by the President when it is deemed necessary. A majority of the Board shall constitute a quorum to transact business.
