which we got off in the boats, except a Captain of the Royal Americans, who we hear is prifoner among the French, but mortally wounded; the Indians, according to their barbarous cuftom, stripped and scalped the dead, and with difficulty this officer escaped, being rescued by some French officers. What lofs the French have fustained we can only guess at, but fuppose it to be confiderable, as a continual fire was kept from our train at Montmorency, and from the Centurion and two armed fhips : our whole body of troops at this attack did not amount to 5000, while the enemy acknowledge theirs to be16000; but the advantage of the ground, not their number, fought against us; and it is the general opinion, that half our troops in their fituation would have been a fufficient match for their whole number.
