

Civil Service Reform.

The spoils and patronage systems are inimical to the highest efficiency of the civil service and to the interests of the country. We propose the creation of a Civil Service Commission, and that appointments and promotions in the service shall be by merit after competitive examination.

Electoral Reform.

We will prohibit under adequate penalties all corporations over which the Province has jurisdiction from making election campaign contributions; require the publication of all election campaign contributions to candidates and political organizations; to provide for the appointment of a public prosecutor as in England, whose duty it shall be to intervene in contested elections to see that all who are guilty of electoral fraud or corruption are duly prosecuted.

I shall take an early opportunity of discussing before the electors the policies herein outlined, and I appeal to all who believe in these policies to give to the Liberal candidates throughout this Province their cordial support.
