Order Games—To Prevent Rag Play. F. C. Waghorne has proposed the follow ing amendments : To strike out Section 5 of Article $V_{i,j}$ and ing amendments: To strike out Section 5 of Article V., and insert the following in lieu thereof : "Play-ers shall not change clubs during the sea-son nucleon the sea-son nucleon the sea-son nucleon the sea-of a school, college or university club, in which case they shall be eligible to play for such school, college or university club, and one other club only, or unless they be members of a junior club in amalgamation with an intermediate club, in which case they shall be allowed promotion to the in-termediate team; but in no case shall any player be allowed to return to the junior club in termediate the same season after having played more than once on the intermediate team.
