What is lyddite? The high explosive thus called from the name of the inventor, the British chemist, Alfred Nobel, is a substance which is made by mixing nitro-cellulose with picric acid.

Common shells of forged steel filled with lyddite are used in the form of shells for breech-loading guns and with howitzers.
