I have the honor to enclose herewith three consent of band to transfer three families from the Fort Alexander Band to the Coucheching Band, the reasons given for the transfer was that they have relatives living on the Coucheching reserve, and that they can get work better here than at Fort Alexander.

There was another application for transfer, brought up at the council, Joseph Boisseneau a member of the Garden River Band, but it was refused by 14 for and 24 against, all the others were by unanimous vote.

I have no objections to these transfers.
