RUFF AND MUFF FOR EVENING WEAR. An unusual combination of materials and one which is very attractive is that of net and marabout in evening accessories such as these. The ruff is three very full ruffles of a closely spotted cream net, each ruffle several inches wider than the other so that the lower one spreads well out over the shoulders. The ends are caught together in the front under ruffles of white satin faced velvet ribbon and the long ribbon ends depend well below the wearer's knees. With this neckpiece is a muff--a perfect billow of net ruffles and marabout, which, by the way, is white shading to a smoky brown color at the ends. On the front of the muff is a many looped bow of the velvet ribbon, and the ruffles of net are given body by a lining of double ruffles of white chiffon. The set is worn with a princess jumper costume of black chiffon broadcloth with all over lace guimpe and black velvet trimmings. The hat is a small shape of white lace trimmed with white ostrich and white roses with green foliage.

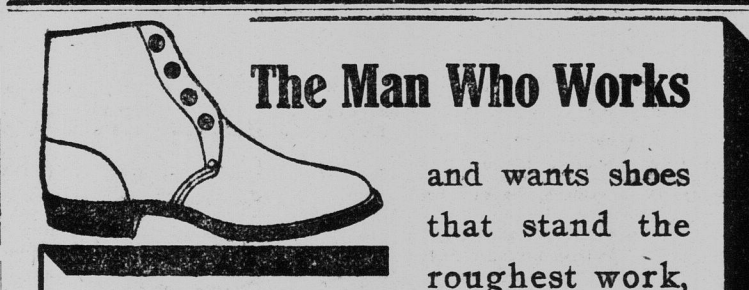
