### MANUSCRIPT

Manuscript secretary, J. W. Maxwell of Webster, P. L. Leavitt of Turner, and A. G. Fuller of Auburn. The bank will be capitalized at \$100,000, with a \$25,000 surplus. This committee will get the bank under way as soon as possible, having general oversight of the subscription to stock and other routine matters. Until they get the business established, it is said the Manufacturers National bank of this city will act as trustee.

This will be the first rural credit bank of Maine, and will do a state-wide business. The primary object is to give the farmer a chance to have equal banking facilities with the merchant or shopkeeper. The scheme has been tried out in the west and been found practical and satisfactory it is claimed. The bank loans the farmer money on long time mortgages, and issues certificates against these mortgages, and runs for one year. So whoever buys them cannot cash them in until the term of the certificate has expired. This gives the bank its chance for its own investments, without danger of disturbance. In addition to this rural credit business, the bank will do regular commercial business, thus increasing the bank service of the two cities this much.
