I recognize the accused because ~~we were~~ ~~and are not in same platoon.~~ I met accused first on 2 Jan 43 at Aldershot. We were with same platoon from then on five weeks. When we arrived, we were placed in different platoons. At I saw accused in curio of town waiting for a truck to get back to camp. This was between 8:30 & 8:45. The accused was drunk.
