WILL BOSTON NATIONALS MAKE CHANGE?

Cincinnati, Nov. 21.—Negotiations are said to be in progress between the Boston Nationals and a company in which Charles Baird of Kansas City and Henry Killilea of Milwaukee are leading factors. President Herrmann is said to be conducting the negotiations, and it is one of the conditions of his aid in this matter that a deal be made which will bring William Sweeney to Cincinnati to take charge of his team.

It is practically certain that Mr. Herrmann will put the deal through at the meeting in New York in December, and that official announcement will doubtless be made at that time. Mr. Baird is a capitalist of Kansas City. For a number of years he was director of athletics at the University of Michigan, and established a reputation in the business end of athletics which is second to none.

Mr. Baird has always taken a keen interest in professional baseball, and has been anxious to secure a controlling interest in some major league club. He applied to Mr. Herrmann to assist him in his ambition and the Cincinnati owner is helping him in his negotiations with the Boston club.
