## LIBERTY BONDS IN STRONG RALLY

New York, May 21.—The rally in Liberty Bonds shortly before noon helped the market somewhat and a few of the formerly popular specialities acted as though some confidence in them was being restored, while other parts of the list were inclined to sag off.

The latter included some of the Steel and Equipments and notably the Sugars. Action of the market in the last hour did not exhibit any definite trend. Liberty Bonds, however, made the best prices in the late trading. It was reported that the Federal Reserve board would request banks not to call old bonds secured on this class of collateral.

Doubtless one influence that prevented stocks from making a big recovery was the tenor of Washington legislation and apparently there is even some idea of framing a measure which will force the declaration of such dividends so they can be taxed. Probably these ideas will not get enacted into law but the prolonged discussion of them is not helpful to security values.
