PROPOSE TO EXTEND WHARF

City Council Committee Urges Plan for a 600-Foot Berth

WOULD ADD TO ONE CLARK IS BUILDING

Some Opposition to Proposal Likely to Be Found at Board of Works Meeting Tuesday--The Views Expressed--Mr. McNeil of C. P. R.

The sub-committee of the board of works appointed to call for tenders for timber for one new berth on the west side met on Wednesday morning and unanimously decided to recommend that, instead of attempting to construct an additional berth, the wharf now under construction should be lengthened 150 feet to make it available for the larger steamers.

It is understood that the committee, after a full discussion, were of opinion that in view of the present rate of progress with the dredging, the additional wharf would not be completed in time for next season's business.

The decision of the committee will likely lead to a considerable discussion by the board. It is claimed by some members of the council that the change which the committee recommend will result in the loss of the wharf when that part of the wharf is ultimately completed.
