What the C. P. R. Intends to do and What is Being Done.

C. M. Richardson of the Canadian Pacific Irrigation Coloni ation Cogave the Free Press the following information about the irrigation proposition:

"Of the 3,000,000 acres, 110,000 are already under irrigation. In the first million section there are nearly 1,000 miles of canals and ditches already made. They tap the Bow river about two miles east of Calgary. It flows into the main canal, which is 17 miles long, 65 feet in width at the care and been content. We shall be care and been content. The irrigated land is worth now \$118 to \$25 an acre. Dry land which lies above the watered areas is sold at \$12 to \$15. For the use of the water: the farmer pays 50 cents year annum, compared to \$4 to \$6 in California, and \$8 to \$10 in Australia. The ditches are maintained for all time by the Canadian Pacific railway, while the government goarnametes the water supply. A government officer is on the spot to regulate the irrigation, and to see that riparlan rights are not infringed.

"The lowest flow of the Bow river is 36 cubic feet per second. The water allowed for each 150 acress is one cubic foot per second from May I to Cotober I, which equals appreximately a rainfall of 15 inches. With the natural rainfall which varies from 11 to 25 inches per annum, the land is completely irrigable.
