against any member of the Company, and to inquire into the character of persons desirous of joining the Company, but who may not be personally known to the officers.

Sec. 3.—The duties of the Financial Committee shall be, to examine all accounts against the Company; to examine the Treasurer's books previous to the Annual Meeting; to decide upon the value of Uniform left by members who have resigned; and to make arrangements for the purchase of clothing and other necessaries for the Company.

Sec. 4.—Each Committee shall keep a record of its proceedings.

RULE VI.

FUNDS.

Sec. 1.—There shall be a Clothing and a Contingent Fund,

· Sec. 2.—The Clothing Fund shall be raised whenever any article of clothing or equipment is required, by a subscription of 5s. per month, from each member, and when he receives his Uniform he shall have paid into said Fund at least \$5.

Sec 3.—The payment of this subscription shall cease whenever a sufficient sum is in the Fund to

cover the amount due by the Company.

Sec. 4.—The members may also place the amount of pay received from Government, into this fund.

Sec. 5.—The Contingent Fund shall be raised by a subscription of 3s. 9d. per annum from each member. The Fines also shall go to this Fund, and it shall be applied to the payment of Rent of
