

12. *Form of Judgment on a Special Case stated by an Arbitrator (vide ante No. 4.)*

(*Copy the Special Case, and then proceed thus*)
 Afterwards on the day of 18 ,
 come here the parties aforesaid and the Court is of
 opinion that (*state the opinion of the Court on the
 question or questions stated in the Case, in the affir-
 mative or negative as the case may be*) Therefore it
 is considered that the Plaintiff do recover against the

13. *Form of an Issue when it is directed to be
 tried by the Judge of the County Court.*

 joinder of Issue proceed as follows*) And forasmuch
 as the sum sought to be recovered and endorsed on
 the copy of the original process served, does not

 trial of Issues joined in the said Court—And when
 the same shall have been tried that he make known
 to the Court here what shall have been done by
 virtue of the Writ of our Lady the Queen to him in
 that behalf directed, with the finding of the Jury
