of 29 G. 3. c. 53. as relates to Seas and Davis's Streights, further continued till March 25, 1810.

And so much seven hundred and eighty-six; and also so much of an Act made in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, An Act for further encouraging and regulating the Newfoundland, Greenland, the Greenland and Southern Whale Fisheries, as relates to the Fisheries carried on in the Greenland Seas and Davis's Streights; which, by an A& made in the Thirty-fecond Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, were amended and continued until the Twenty-fifth Day of December One thousand feven hundred and ninety-eight, and which were by feveral sublequent Acts further continued, and by Two Acts passed in the Forty-second and Forty-fourth Years of the Reign of His present Majesty, were amended and further continued, and by an Act of the Forty-fixth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty further continued until the Twenty-fifth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and eight, shall be and the fame is hereby further continued until the Twenty-fifth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and ten.

So much of 43G.3.c. 68. as relates to to Entry of Oil or Blubber, &c. further continued till March 25, 1810.

II. And be it further enacted, That so much of an Act made in the Forty-third Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, An Act the Admission to repeal the Duties of Customs payable in Great Britain, and to grant other Duties in lieu thereof, as relates to the Admission to Entry of Oil or Blubber of Fish, or Creatures living in the Sea, actually caught and taken on the Banks and Shores of the Island of Newfoundland and Parts adjacent, wholly by His Majesty's Subjects carrying on the said Fishery from the faid Island, and residing therein, on Payment of the Duty by the faid Act imposed, on Train Oil or Blubber of Newfoundland of British Fishing, which was to continue in force until the Twenty-fifth Day of December One thousand eight hundred and four, and which was by Three Acts passed in the Forty-fourth, Forty-fifth, and Forty-fixth Years of His present Majesty's Reign, further continued until the Twenty-fifth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and eight, shall be and the same is hereby further continued until the Twenty-fifth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and ten.

4-G.3. c. 24. continued till March 25, 1810.

III. And be it further enacted, That an Act made in the Forty-seventh Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, An Act for allowing, until the First Day of August One thousand eight hundred and eight, the Importation of certain Fish from Newfoundland and the Coast of Labrador, and for granting a Bounty thereon, shall be and the same is hereby continued until the Twenty-fifth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and ten.
