in his Absence, the Lieutenant Governoz of the said Illands, Colonies, or Provinces respectively, to import. into the same, in British Ships owned by his Wajetty's Subjects, and navigated according to Law, any Megroes, Bousehold Kurniture, Utensils of Husbandip, or Cloathing, free of Duty: Provided always, Chat such bouse: hold furniture, Utentils of Husbandep, and Cloathing. thall not in the Mhole exceed the Calue of Fifty Pounds for every White Person that shall belong to such Kamily; and the Calue of Forty Shillings for every Pegro brought by such White Person; and if any Dispute hall arise as to the Calue of such Household Kurniture, Utensis of busbander, or Cloathing, the same shall be heard and determined by the Arbitration of Three British Werchants at the Post where the same hall be imposted, One of such British Werchants to be appointed by the Governoz. or in his Absence the Lieutenant Governor of such Jaand or Province, One by the Collector of the Customs at such Port, and One by the Person so coming with his Family.

Sales of Negroes, &c. fo imported, within 12 Months, to be void. II. And he it further enacted, That all Sales of Bargains for the Sale of any Megro, household Kurniture, Utensils of husbandry, or Cloathing, so imported, which thall be made within Twelve Calendar Months after the Importation of the same, (except in Cases of the Bankruptcy or Death of the Owner thereof), thall be null and boid to all Intents and Purposes whatsoever.

All White Persons coming so to reside, to take the Oath of Allegiance, if upwards of 14 Years old. III. And he it further enacted, That every White Person to coming to relide, if above the Age of Kourteen Pears, Hall, and he is hereby required, immediately after his Arrival, to take and subscribe the Dath of Allegiance to His Wajelly, His Heirs and Successors, before the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Thief Wagistrate of the Place where such Person shall arrive, and at the same Time swear that it is his Intention to reside and settle in such Island or Province; for which Daths such Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Chief Wagistrate, shall receive the same Kee, and no more, as is payable by Law on administering the Dath of Allegiance in Tales where the same is now by Law required.
