In connection with portable Saw Mill Permit No. 265, which expired on the Ist February last, I have to request that you will have same returned to has Department along with the Affidavit thereon properly completed, shewing all the operations conducted thereunder by you, also to furnish a Mill Return shewing the disposition of the 20,454 feet B.M. of Manufactured Timber shewn to be on hand by the Mill Return for the Quarter ended on the 31st March last.

I may say that the Department of the Interior advises that it will be absolutely necessary that all the Timber obtained under Permit No. 265, should be shewn to have been disposed of as required by the Regulations, otherwise Trespass Dues must be charged and collected.

Kindly advise whether it is desired that a Renewal Permit be taken out for the second year.
