As William Hill failed to pay this emount, the Department in September last instructed the Agent to take a sufficient portion of the land received by William under the division of the estate to satisfy Mrs. Brant's claim.

I will take the matter up with the Agent again, and endeavour to have a settlement made as speedily as possible.
