



I transmit herewith copy of a letter of the 24th ultimo, from Chief Wilson Sampson, of Sheshegwaning, who makes complaint that he has not been paid for work done at the school garden, although he submitted an account to Mr. Baxter, the Indian Agent. The Department desires that you will make careful inquiry into this matter and endeavour to ascertain why the account for the work at the school, as well as the other account referred to, have not been sent to the Department. You should see that these accounts are forwarded to Head-quarters immediately.
