The Government intend, therefore, immediately to establish a War Supply Board, posponsible to the Minister of Finance with powers generally similar in scope to those, which, under the proposed legislation, would be given to the persentation Munitions and Supply. The Government already have, in the opinion of their legal divisors, authority to set up such a Board under the War Measures Act. It was felt, however, that, as time went on, it might quite possibly appear that a separate Ministry was justified.
