These are the airplanes that was destroyed in the fire:

Cessna 180 - CF - IXQ Piper Pacer - CF - EBU Piper Pacer - CF - EST Piper PA12 - CF - JQR Piper PA18A - CF - LSI Piper PALS - CF - JVW - CF - EGV Piper J3 - CF - GOU Piper J3 - CF - EEE

Also three fuselages which were hoping to rebuild at sometime these were

Piper J3 - CF - BRT - CF - DLJ Piper J3

- CF - BEEN Piper J3

There was not any of our airplanes saved at all everything went in the fire, plus all our records, which also included the log books for these aircraft, Hoping that this is satisfactory.
