Book of Revelations vi. 9-11, there you will find them still alive, waiting to come with Christ in His King-Revelations vi. 9-11, "And when He had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the Word of God, and for the testimony which they held." 10, "And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth." 11, "And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellow-servants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled." Beloved, the killing of the body is not death to the born-again man in Christ Jesus. The moment the body is killed the soul enters into a fuller life in the Glory: it is not so with the sinless man in the flesh. He is baptized for the dead, sealed unto the day of redemption by the Holy Ghost.

But there was another class standing by our blessed Lord when He said, "There be some standing here which shall not taste of death till they see the Son of Man coming in His Kingdom." and that class was the true Bride of the Lamb which you will find in the 14th Chapter of Revelations. The Bride of the Lamb never tastes of death. When they leave the earthly body they go into the Glory. Death cannot touch them (Revelations xiv. 4). These are they which were not defiled with women, for they are virgins; these are they which follow the Lamb wheresoever He goeth. These were redeemed from
