Grand river, which is navigable to within 3 miles of the city, a canal affording navigation the balance of the way. In Brantford township, Brant County, of which it is the county seat. Settled in 1836. It was incorporated in 1877 as a city. It is on the B & G line of the G T Ry, and the B & T line of the southern div of the same road passes through the city. It has several important industries including brick yards, potteries, foundries, flour, cotton and woolen mills, winery factory, agricultural implement works, engine and machine works, the extensive shops of the G T Ry, etc, etc. It contains 2 Episcopal, 5 Methodist, 3 Baptist, 1 Congregational, Catholic and Presbyterian churches, 4 public schools with 1,200 pupils, a collegiate institute, owned by the city, with 8 teachers, and a young ladies' college. A free library of 5,300 volumes, an opera house seating 1,000, the John H Stratford Hospital, costing \$22,000, and several public halls, a city hall, a court house, and county offices. The provincial asylum for the blind is situated just without the city limits. It has 4 banks, and 3 daily newspapers, publishing weekly editions, viz, the *Expositor*, *Telegram* and *Courier*, and one monthly, the *Canadian Forester*. Grain, flour, produce, line and the products of the manufactories are shipped. Assessed valuation of real and personal property, \$4,398,790, bonded indebtedness, \$259,218. The city is lighted with gas and electricity, has excellent water-works, a good fire department, and telephone communication. Stage to Burford daily, fare 50c. Telegraph, GNW. Express, American. Mail daily. Distance from Toronto 66 miles, from Montreal 400 miles, from Buffalo N Y, 78 miles. Population, 12,000. Alexander Clement, postmaster.
